## Memorandum of Understanding for Collaboration on

Interdisciplinary Research, Integrating
Ecological and Conservation related Research in Longleng
District.

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is signed between YINGLI COLLEGE, LONGLENG and LEMSACHENLOK, LONGLENG: NAGALAND to work together in supporting Indigenous Community Biodiversity Conservation initiatives, particularly in the fields of education and capacity building in the fight to protect the natural world and the biodiversity within it.
